

ENROLMENT POLICY

Children who are in the catchment area for Stirling North Primary School are given first priority when taking on new enrolments. This means that we may not have vacancies for non-Stirling North residents who wish to enrol with us. The capacity of the school and the needs of the students determine the maximum number of students who can enrol.

Stirling North Primary School supports the enrolment of the residents of Stirling North. To ensure that the school can provide a high quality, safe program for all students, enrolments are maintained at a reasonable level. The Principal, Staff members and Governing Council work together using the DECD guidelines to define the maximum number of enrolments each year.

First Priority:

Students who have a residential address in our local catchment area.

- You may be asked to provide proof of residence by showing an electricity bill, rental agreement, contract of sale, etc.

Second Priority:

Students who already have siblings enrolled at the school.

Third Priority:

Students who have been enrolled at the Stirling North Childhood Services Centre.

Fourth Priority:

Student living outside of Stirling North.

The school will determine a safe enrolment limit to ensure that the school has the capacity to allow the enrolment of Stirling North residents. If the school has reached its capacity, out of zone students will go on a waiting list for consideration if a vacancy becomes available.
